COSTS

Costs of the Sydney Chevra Kadisha providing funeral services (inclusive of GST) are as follows:

DISBURSEMENTS (OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES)

A. The only **compulsory disbursements** to be paid by the client are:

A Talith – for men only, and only if not provided by the client	\$51.00
The Rabbi's fee. The client may choose a Rabbi from the schedule attached	Average \$400.00
Live Streaming of the funeral at the Woollahra chapel	\$110.00

B. Other disbursements are at the **discretion of the client** and will incur the following additional charges:

A Sunday or Public Holiday funeral incurs an additional Basic Service Charge	\$1,100.00
Death Certificate (one original from Registrar General)	\$60.00
Removal of body by another funeral company: cost price	Approx. \$365.00

LOCATION

The Sydney Chevra Kadisha mortuary is located at 172 Oxford Street, Woollahra (entrance via Wallis Street) and funeral services can take place at the Woollahra premises, Ohel Chaim Chapel at Macquarie Park Cemetery or Rookwood Cemetery without further charge.

CEMETERY FEES

Each cemetery charges an interment fee and a fee for the plot. The fees charged by each individual cemetery vary greatly and must be negotiated directly between the client and the cemetery of your choice. Those fees are charged to you by the cemetery directly and are to be paid to the cemetery directly.
